



EXHIBIT "A" SMOF ON HORIZONTAL HOLD


EXHIBIT "B" SMOF ON VERTICAL HOLD








This piece is called "Blue Moses," which is more obvious on the color version. Even so, it defies any explanation.













These illustrations may be familiar from fan art shows, where they were among my most popular pieces. Except that these are the versions that ran in fanzines first.











Two Authors observing people




PEOPLE SOMETIMES WOUNDER WHY I DATE ALL MY CHATOONS ...
